The Anglonordic Life Science Conference XIV will be held in London on the 31st of May 2017. Now entering its fourteenth year the conference will be held at the prestigious 8 Northumberland Avenue in central London.

The conference has a "by-invitation-only" policy. The select audience is restricted to decision makers representing drug discovery and medtech companies from the Anglo-Nordic regions and international pharmaceutical and investment firms. Service suppliers can attend as sponsors or exhibitors.

The conference includes several Guest Countries. Each country participates with a delegation of R&D companies and investment firms.

At the 2016 conference, 70 investment firms attended.

The conference consists of five areas that have simultaneous activities. the main conference room (biotech,) the annex room (medtech), the one-to-one Meetings Area (meetings are booked online in advance, or on the day), the Exhibiting Area and the Salon (Lounge).

In the evening of the 30th of May, the conference starts with an exclusive Reception. The guest of honour at the Reception 2016 was George Freeman, Minister for Life Sciences in the UK.

The History of 8 Northumberland Avenue

The Percy family, the Dukes of Northumberland, built their family seat - Northumberland House - at the beginning of the 17th century.

Some considerable size, the entire estate was bought in 1874 by the Metropolitan Board of Works and Northumberland Avenue was created. In 1887, the Hotel Victoria was built at number 8 - a first-class hotel that operated right up until the 1940s, when it was requisitioned by the War Office and occupied by the Crown. The doors of 8 Northumberland Avenue remained closed to the public for 70 years.

In 2009, a near-derelict building was inherited from the Ministry Of Defence. It took a year of major refurbishment to restore the building to its former grand Victorian style. The multi-million pound restoration was completed on time and on budget. The doors of 8 Northumberland Avenue were once again open to the public in the spring of 2010.

The magnificent rooms are one of the grandest Victorian hotel interiors remaining in London and today they represent the Anglonordic Life Science Conference.

The Reception

The 2016 conference started with an exclusive Reception at the prestigious Australia House, hosted by the Guest country South Australia. The guest of honour at the Reception was George Freeman, Minister for Life Sciences in the UK.

The Reception venue for 2017 will be announced soon; the evening will start at 18.00 and end at around 20.30 and is free of charge for conference delegates. As a tradition the Reception is held at one of the Ambassadors's Residences in London.
